EuroSun, the premier European solar energy conference, is being held in the newly completed Saltire Centre of Glasgow Caledonian University, Scotland, 26-30 June 2006, and is organised on behalf of ISES-Europe by the Solar Energy Society (UK-ISES), the United Kingdom national section of ISES together with the Scottish Solar Energy Group (SSEG).

EuroSun 2006 is sponsored by Thameswey Energy Ltd., Scottish Enterprise, Scottish Power Renewables and SUST UK, and the event is supported by the European Commission Intelligent Energy Europe programme.
